

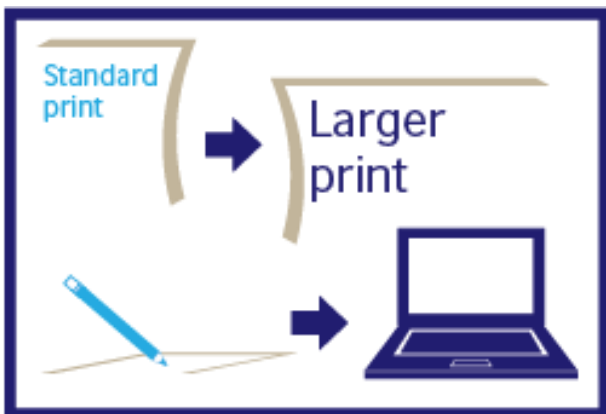
Our Inclusion Policy
