Service 2 + Reviewed Script	The same as a 'review of marking' but you also get a copy of the reviewed script.	LKR 28,600	LKR 31,680

Special Note:

Please note that only review of moderation (Service 3) service is available for **9FA0**. If you wish to apply for EAR service for this subject, please write to info.lk@britishcouncil.org for further information on the process and fees.

Refunds for EAR are given only under the following circumstances:

IAL:

- Cashed-in Subject (i.e., awarded an overall subject grade) – If the EAR leads to an improvement in the overall subject grade.
- Non-cashed in Subject – If the EAR leads to an improvement in the unit grade.
- Cashed-in Subject with multiple units requested for EAR- Only the EAR unit contributing towards an improvement in the overall subject grade will be refunded.

IGCSE / GCSE:

- Refund of fees (per relevant subject) will be applicable only if the EAR service leads to an improvement in the overall subject grade.

Note: Candidates' marks and subject grades may be confirmed, lowered or increased. Where there has been a reduction in marks or a downgrade, the request cannot be revoked, and the original mark or grade cannot be reinstated. If the candidate is eligible for a refund, it will be processed within six weeks of receiving the outcome for the Enquiry.

3. Late Cash-In for October/November 2025 series

Candidates, who have completed the required number of units, may apply for this service.

Deadline – 06 February 2026 (Late requests will not be accommodated)

Fees

- Per Cash In – LKR 7,800

Note: Late Cash-ins for October/November 2025 series are only allowed up to the above deadline. Any cash in requests made after the above date will need to be submitted as a Special Late cash-In request.

Requirements:

- Late Cash-In application form.
- Copies of Statements of Results (*Current and all relevant previous results sheets*)
- Copy of your ID (*Name should appear in English*)

If there are any mistakes in the spelling of your name, date of birth and gender, apply for “Data Changes” before the given deadline using the form linked below.

You will receive your Electronic Statement of Results within 24 hours of the results release timeline mentioned above.

- **Private Candidates** - Sent via email to the registered email address.
- **School Candidates** - Sent to the respective schools.



6. Hard Copies of Statement of Results (SOR) and Certificates

You will receive your SOR before 15 February 2026 and the certificate before 30 April 2026.

- **Private Candidates** – Will receive via courier to the exam registered address
- **School Candidates** - Sent to the respective schools.
